RANGE LINE ROAD UPDATE

Traffic switches to Northbound; work continues

CARMEL, IN – The North Range Line Road improvement project will see some big changes today as construction crews continue to work on drainage structures in the roadway from 8th Street (Smoky Row) to the U.S. 31 overpass. The project has been delayed the last few weeks due to early onset of freezing temperatures and utility delays.

After 5 p.m. today, traffic will begin to flow northbound only – just in time for Black Friday and early holiday shopping at Clay Terrace. This change will remain in place for as long as the weather permits construction to continue.

At some point over the next few weeks – unless we experience a dramatic warming trend – the project is likely to come to a winter stopping point, at which time the road will return to a two-way traffic pattern throughout the rest of the winter months. Construction would then resume in early spring.

Today's traffic switch will take place between 4-5 p.m. During the changeover, Range Line will be temporarily closed to through-traffic and then reopen to northbound traffic.
