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### **Traffic updates: Carey Road closures, Spring Mill Road first phase, Johnson Addition storm water project, street paving**

#### **[Carey Road and Hawthorne Drive](#)**

##### **Closure: Monday, September 26**

This intersection is scheduled to be closed on Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup> prior to 8 a.m. for construction of a new roundabout. The closure is scheduled to last 45 days. This project will increase vehicular and alternative (pedestrian/bike) transportation connectivity. The detour will use Gray Road and Keystone Parkway to accommodate northbound and southbound traffic. Eastbound and westbound traffic will use Main Street and 146th street.

#### **[Carey Road and 136<sup>th</sup> Street](#)**

##### **Closure: During first week of October**

This intersection will remain open for a few more weeks. It is anticipated that it may be closed sometime during the first week of October. This is for construction of a roundabout. Detour will use Gray Road and Keystone Parkway to accommodate northbound and southbound traffic. Eastbound and westbound traffic will use Main Street and 146th street.

## **Spring Mill Road Improvement**

### **Closure: On or After October 9**

Signs are up now to let motorists know that construction will begin on or after October 9<sup>th</sup> on Spring Mill Road from Main Street to Dorset. This will be a full closure until about mid-December. A detour will be in place, using Illinois Street for all north-south traffic. This is the first phase of an \$8.3 million project that will add multi-purpose paths so that there are no gaps in connectivity; a new median in the center of the roadway and pedestrian railings to bridges. Future phases will include work in 2017 further south on Spring Mill, from Dorset to 111<sup>th</sup> Street. Reith Riley is the contractor on this project.

## **Emerson Road storm water improvement**

### **Lane Restrictions Only: On or After September 26**

The City of Carmel has been working on storm water improvements in the Emerson Road area. On or after September 26, this project will shift into the Johnson Addition area of Emerson Road. The storm sewer installation will continue along the southern portion of Emerson as well as 350 feet of York Drive from Emerson, and the length of Park Lane. Local traffic will be maintained. Weather permitting, this project should be completed by Thanksgiving.

## **City street paving – various streets**

### **Lane Restrictions Only: Ongoing**

The City Street Department continues to complete its 2016 paving projects. The following streets are expected to be paved during the next few weeks, weather permitting, as the construction season nears its end. Please be alert as you travel on these roads.

Sutton Place Drive – Sutton Avenue to Westbury Place  
Ventana Court – Spring Highland Drive to End  
Westbury Place – Sutton Avenue to Sutton Place Drive

### **CarmelLink 2.0 Update**

*CARME LINK 2.0 is a concentrated infrastructure improvement program that will result in the completion of new roundabout intersections along Gray Road, 96th Street, Range Line Road, 116<sup>th</sup> Street, Guilford Road, Pennsylvania Street, Spring Mill Road, Towne Road, Keystone Parkway with a new interchange at 96th Street, storm water management and drainage improvement projects throughout the City of Carmel. It will also include the upgrade of a large section of Range Line Road and other miscellaneous improvements over the next three-years.*
